

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS for Revelation 3:7-13,
The Church in Philadelphia

1. In this passage what highlights do you notice about Jesus' person? How might these qualities encourage our relationship with Him? What are ways you can grow as one who is "holy and true"?

2. How does an open door encourage us to move forward? What "open doors" are you experiencing in your spiritual life these days?

3. What might a "synagogue of Satan" consist of? How are we to understand Satan and how ought this reality of personal evil affect our daily walk? How could you be more adequately prepared for this conflict?

4. What does it look like in today's society to keep His Word and not deny His name? Are there any of His Words you should be more earnest to "keep"?

5. What do we know from this passage about the 'hour of testing'? What is Jesus' promise in this regard? To whom does Jesus offer this promise? How should this motivate us?

6. When we are undergoing great difficulty how does Jesus' soon return affect us? Why do you think here again (like His promise to Smyrna) Jesus speaks of our crown? What motivates us to deeply desire a crown from Him?

7. How can we overcome despite our weakness?

8. What does being a pillar in the temple of God intimate to us? What are ways we can practically "overcome" in our lives day by day?
