

LOVING & MENTORING ONE ANOTHER DISCUSSION QUESTIONS
Read John 13:34-35 and Ephesians 4:15-16

The clear teaching of over 60 New Testament verses is that the Body of Christ is to be a people deeply connected to one another, building each other up, and loving one another.

1. Who are some believers you are deeply connected to and how have they built you up in the Lord?
2. If you can't name anyone, perhaps something may be impeding. Practically, what might help you to develop a close relationship with a few other people in the church?
3. Were you mentored (disciplined) by other people when you were growing up? Explain how that happened and the impact on your life.
4. To whom or where will you go to get the mentoring process going for yourself?
5. What current situation for potential growth might cause you to seek out a mentor to help you?
6. When have you experienced God's grace and love more fully because you chose to open your heart to a brother or sister in Christ?
7. Are you available to be a mentor to someone else in the church? Why or why not?
