

### **Truths that Transform**

#### **God's communicable attributes: He is worthy of all our worship**

We focus this week on those elements in God's nature that He has shared with mankind. We can consider these attributes in two categories:

##### **God's personal attributes:**

1) Romans 11:33 How does God's wisdom and knowledge compare to ours? How does it help you knowing that God knows all things?

2) Psalm 33:4-11 What motives does this psalm give us to worship God? What personal attributes do you notice mentioned here?

3) How should God's being "upright and faithful" encourage us? What does this imply? How might we reflect these qualities as we relate to others?

4) If the plans of His heart are fulfilled from generation to generation, what does that tell us of God's sovereignty in the affairs of men? What about when unpleasant things happen? How do we react to the Lord when bad things happen?

##### **God's moral attributes:**

5) Isaiah 6:1-7 Why do you suspect the seraphim covered their faces from God's presence? How did Isaiah respond to this vision? How did God respond to Isaiah's response? How can we apply this sort of interaction in our lives? What was the impact in Isaiah's life... and in ours?

6) I John 4:8-11 What are some of the things implied in saying God is love? How are we to respond to God's love? How can we share this?

7) Psalm 68:5 What elements of God's nature are evident here? How might we get involved in reflecting these elements of God's heart?

8) Exodus 34: 6-7 Which of God's attributes mentioned here do you most appreciate and why? What might it be like if God were quick to anger? How about us? Can you give an example of how God's forgiveness has blessed you?
